**Chelan County Shoreline Master Program Update**

Chelan County does hereby request qualifications for professional services for assisting with the Chelan County Shoreline Master Program Update. The update includes the County and the Cities within the County. Initial services required include conducting a shoreline inventory and may also include other services as requested, including assistance with public participation and community visioning; shoreline characterization; goals, policy and regulatory development; cumulative impact analysis; restoration planning; and final plan development.

Consultants who are interested in providing these services are requested to send 25 copies of the following:

- Statement of qualifications (including prior similar experience)
- A letter expressing an interest in providing the aforementioned services, and
- A general project approach, including timeline

The County has established an Advisory Committee, consisting of diverse stakeholders from the community, who will review submitted SOQs and make a selection based on the written SOQ and interviews. Chelan County is the lead agency for this project and will oversee the contract.

Interested parties must reply by 5:00 PM PST on February 1, 2008 for their qualifications to be considered. Interviews will occur on February 12, 2008.
