Parking Lot Questions/Issues

- Assess lake quality for drinking water – many residents pull drinking water directly from the lake
- Drinking water is an important issue – this effort needs to involve the health district
- Establish current conditions and determine historical conditions... what has changes? Are the changes resulting from natural processes or human caused? Positive or negative?
- Invasive species – investigate milfoil
- Include information/data from residents – many have collected information/photos/etc for years and have a wealth of knowledge
- Look at other examples (Lake Stevens, Lake Chelan, Lake Tahoe)
- 2007 Monitoring and Evaluation Report has information on sockeye returns and where they are spawning.
- Conduct current studies – flow movement through the lake
- Look at sediment inputs from development
- Inputs from precipitation?
- Septic system evaluation – concern over leaking septic. What is the authority of the health district?
- How do you determine if a septic system is failing?
- Monitor for fecal coliform
- Nutrients – identify types and sources
- Education
