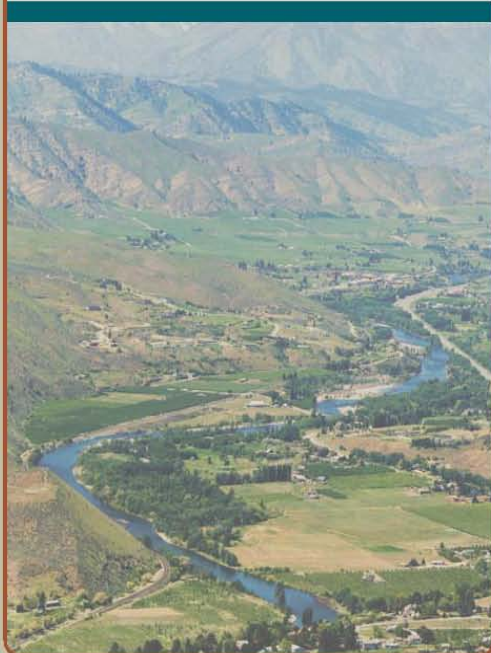

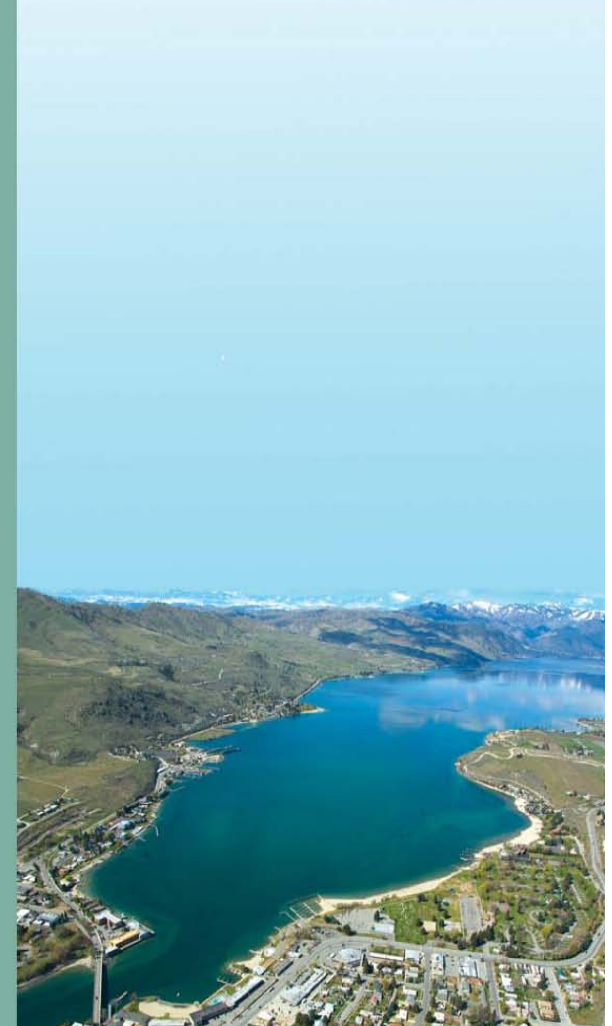

What is an SMP?

Chelan County and the Cities of Cashmere, Chelan, Entiat, Leavenworth, and Wenatchee are partnering to update their Shoreline Master Program (SMP) in accordance with the Shoreline Management Act. The SMP provides environmental protection for shorelines, preserves and enhances public access, and encourages appropriate development that supports water-dependent uses.

What are shorelines?

The SMP applies to shorelines of the state, including lakes greater than 20 acres, streams with a mean annual flow greater than 20 cubic feet per second (cfs), upland areas within 200 feet of the ordinary high water mark, floodways, some floodplains, and associated wetlands. Chelan County has at least 130 shorelines of the state, which include approximately 80 streams and rivers, and 50 lakes.

What do shoreline rules cover?

The updated SMP will be compatible with other existing County and City goals, policies, and regulations such as comprehensive plans, development regulations, and watershed plans. The SMP update will affect land use activities that occur in shoreline jurisdiction, just as it has for the past three decades, but will recognize new information about shoreline conditions and protection. The SMP regulates building height; construction of in-water structures; water-dependent uses such as residential docks and marinas; land development such as clearing, grading, dredging, or filling; and other activities.

How long will it take?

The SMP update and adoption process is anticipated to take three years. Existing County and City SMPs will remain in effect until the updated plans are adopted.
